Enduro Race Rules 2023



-
- No SUV's.
 - No 4 wheel-drives.
 - No all-wheel drives.
 - It is highly recommended to have a rollover bar with approved metal and welds.
 - No fence post, T post, etc.
 - We do have the right to refuse your rollover bar due to it being unsafe.
 - All seatbelts must be functionable for driver and passengers.
 - If your windshield has been removed, you must have a minimum of three bars, welded or bolted in the place of the windshield.
 - If your side glasses and windshield have been busted out, all glass must be removed or your car will NOT pass tech.
 - No headlights
 - No trim
 - All doors must be welded, bolted, or chained shut.
 - You must have a minimum of 18-inch tall numbers on each side of the car and on the roof.
 - If your battery has been relocated into the car, it must have a rubber mat covering it and secured.
 - If your fuel tank is removed from underneath and installed inside the car, it must have a rubber mat covering it and be strapped securely.
 - A four-door car can have a total of four people.
 - A two-door car can have a total of two people.
 - You must have 1 fire extinguisher per 2 people in the vehicle.
 - You and your passenger/passengers are the only people that can be in the pit area.
 - You cannot have a pit crew sitting in the infield, you will be disqualified if anyone else is in pit area.
 - Absolutely no passing during a red flag
 - No rough driving, these are Enduro races not demolition derbies.
 - Like all rules, there is a grey area, but if it says you can't do it, then don't.
